

Measure "L" Program Update

January 2014





Program Status

- The District's design team has received comments back from the Division of the State Architect (DSA) for all projects
- DSA provides design and construction oversight for K-12 schools and reviews plans in the three major areas of structural, life safety, and access
- The design team is currently addressing comments received from DSA on the projects. DSA approval is anticipated by March 2014
- The team has developed detailed cost estimates for the projects and is reviewing alternates to reconcile the budget and scope for the first phase of construction
- Upon DSA approval, funding applications will be submitted to the Office of Public School Construction (OPSC)
- The State's program review subcommittee will be presenting its final recommendation to the full State Allocation Board (SAB) on January 22nd for a potential State bond
